Understanding Bolsonaroism: Ideology, Social Movement, or Public Opinion Phenomenon?

This session examines the nature of Bolsonaroism through a review of existing literature. We will focus on three major analytical approaches that differ in how they conceptualize their subject matter — as an ideology (or discourse), as a social movement, or as a public opinion phenomenon — and in the methodologies they employ. We will then review findings from qualitative and quantitative analyses of Bolsonaro voters' policy and value preferences, which provide a critical perspective on these approaches.

João Feres Jr. is a full professor of political science at IESP-UERJ and leading researcher of the Multidisciplinary Study Group on Affirmative Action (GEMAA), and of the Media and Public Space Studies Lab (LEMEP). His current research focuses on the extreme right, populism, misinformation, political behavior, political theory, affirmative action policies, and race relations.
